



Dear Students and Parents/Carers,

As a Positive Behaviour School, we are excited to announce our Victoria Point Values (VPV) Reward Activities for 2026.

These activities are to recognise the efforts of our students for 92% attendance at school, showing high performance in the school recognised values - Respect, Integrity and Responsibility - as evidenced by the gaining of VPV Points.

Students are recognised with a certificate for attaining 92% attendance. All students who are awarded VPV points are automatically entered into a raffle throughout the Term.

Students will also be recognised when they reach significant milestones:

Bronze level: 500 VPV points	Certificate, Badge and \$10 VPV Money voucher (to spend at school)
Silver level: 1000 VPV points	Certificate, Badge and \$20 VPV Money voucher (to spend at school)
Gold level: 1500 VPV points	Certificate, Badge and \$30 VPV Money voucher (to spend at school)

The VPV Team is also pleased to announce that students who demonstrate our values of respect, integrity and responsibility throughout the Term will be eligible for the end of Term reward events.

To be eligible for these events, students **MUST** meet the following criteria:

- 92% attendance or above (Year to Date)
- No suspensions in the 10 school weeks prior (to the date the list is generated)
- 2026 financial commitments paid to date or engaged in an official school payment plan
- Permission from parents for eligible students for the End of Semester off campus activities will be required on QParents,
- Payment required for off-campus events for travel and entry.

In Term 1 and 3:

Term 1 Cross country and Colour Run day will be supported by a VPV Stall for eligible students – possibly a snow cone reward.

Term 3 Spring Thing will be supported by a VPV Stall for eligible students – focus yet to be arranged.



End of Semester 1 and 2 Major Events: will be like previous years where students have had the opportunity to attend an off-campus reward day, e.g. Movie World and Wet'N'Wild.

We kindly ask that you make sure any necessary updates or corrections are completed before the eligibility deadline of Week 5 (of the term for the event), as we won't be able to extend the date. Thank you for your understanding.

High Importance: These events use digital consent only. As our school transitions to the online QParents platform for all excursions in 2026, consent forms and payments for this event will be processed exclusively through the QParents platform.

Email invitations will be sent to eligible students once the list is generated. The event will be available on QParents once students receive their invitations. If you have not yet registered for QParents, we encourage you to complete your registration before this date to ensure you can promptly provide consent and make payment if your child receives an invitation. **Payment deadlines are fixed and cannot be extended**, so please ensure all requirements are completed on time.
