Through their SET Plan goals, students continue to reflect on their future pathways, skills and tertiary education options. The subject selections they have made this year are designed to align with their interests and support their long-term career aspirations.

Towards the end of the term, selected students and their parents/caregivers will be invited to our Celebration Week events. We look forward to recognising and celebrating their hard work and commitment throughout the year.
