In Pathways for Success, students have been developing practical career skills by creating résumés and cover letters, as well as researching and applying for real job opportunities within the community. These activities are strengthening their communication skills and preparing them for their chosen career fields.

All Year 10 students are also expected to have obtained a USI (Unique Student Identifier). A USI is required for students undertaking nationally recognised vocational education and training (VET) or higher education in Australia.

Through their SET Plan goals, students continue to reflect on their future pathways, skills, and tertiary education options. The subject selections they have made this year are intended to complement their interests and support their long-term career aspirations.

In addition, selected Year 10 students have been assisting with the Primary Transition Days held every Wednesday.

They have proudly taken our future students on tours of the school, demonstrating leadership and responsibility. We encourage these students to apply for the Year 11 Peer Leader role in 2026. Peer Leaders work closely with Year 7 family group teachers, mentoring and guiding our new students as they transition to secondary school.
