

eLearning @VPSHS – Parent information

At Victoria Point SHS, we integrate technology into the classroom to enhance learning, improve digital literacy, and prepare students for the future. By using a range of digital tools, students can engage in interactive learning experiences, collaborate with peers, and develop essential 21st-century skills.

Student Technology Induction

All students receive an induction on how to access and effectively use key digital platforms, including:

- **Daymap** – for accessing timetables, assignments, and teacher communication.
- **Office 365** – for creating, storing, and sharing documents using tools like Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and OneNote.
- **Education Perfect** – for interactive learning and revision across various subjects.
- **Emails** – for school communication and collaboration.
- **ReadCloud** – for digital textbooks and reading materials.
- **Other Technologies** – students may be introduced to additional platforms relevant to their subjects.
- **Specialist Programs** - In addition to the core platforms, subject-specific programs may be introduced in class to support learning in particular areas. Teachers will guide students in using these technologies appropriately.

In-Class Device Expectations

To maintain a productive learning environment, students are expected to:

- Use devices for educational purposes only during class time.
- Follow teacher instructions regarding when and how devices should be used.
- Keep notifications and social media use turned off during lessons.
- Ensure devices are charged and ready for use before arriving at school.
- Respect school policies on appropriate online behavior and digital citizenship.

Wi-Fi Expectations

To ensure a safe and secure learning environment, students must connect their devices to the school's approved networks:

- **EQNET or iDET Wi-Fi** – These networks provide secure access to online resources required for learning.
- **Hot spotting is not allowed** – Students must not use mobile hotspots or other external networks to access the internet at school.


Accessing Daymap



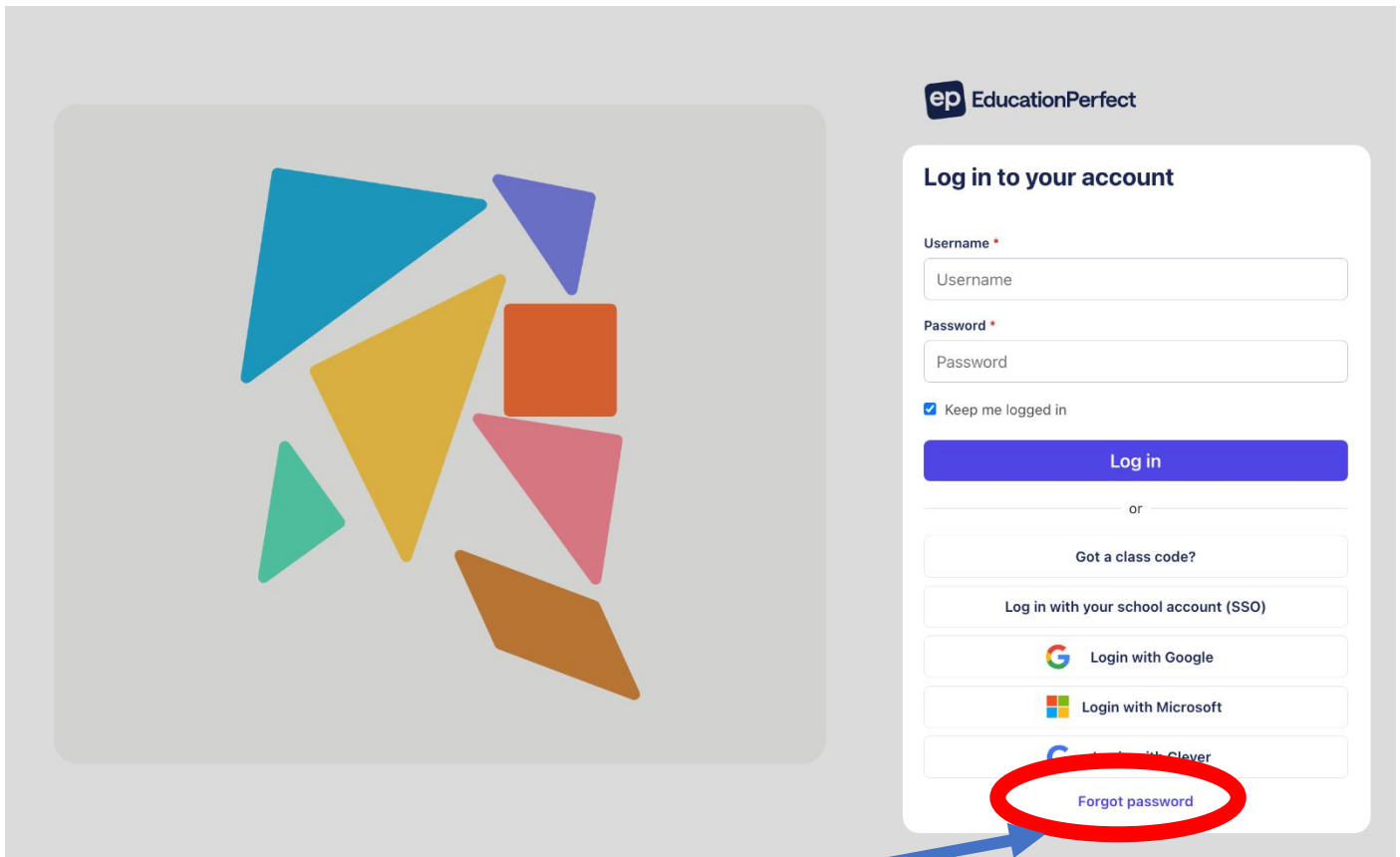
